Echo Partner Reading

Reading aloud to practice fluency and prosody

Suggested Time: 15 minutes

Strategy

Support struggling readers in a shared partner reading and summarizing experience.

Optimal Application Notes

The text should be short and at students' independent reading level and use familiar terms and vocabulary. Rhyming or structured repeated phrasing will also be helpful.

Before:

- Assign student partners.
- Provide reading materials at students' independent reading levels.
- Instruct students on sitting ear to ear in a classroom space.

During:

- Student A reads the first page (the stronger reader if partners are paired strategically).
- Student B echo reads, or repeats, what partner A just read.
- Continue until time is up or students complete a short text.

After:

- Students write a summary together.
- Students write one connection (text to text, text to self, text to world).

Skills Targeted:

- Reading accuracy + rate = fluency
- Prosody & expression
- Summarizing
